

ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION SUNDAY 12 JULY 2026

HELLO WESTMINSTER AND CITY OF LONDON COMMUNITY,

We are excited to let you know that the Saucony London 10K will be returning to the heart of London on Sunday 12 July 2026.

The race route remains very similar to 2025, starting on Piccadilly and finishing on Whitehall, and will involve road closures in your area. We are working with local authorities, TfL and emergency services to minimise disruptions caused.

There are a number of charity and entertainment points with live music and PA systems across the route - see locations at www.thelondon10k.com/route-map. Sound levels will be monitored throughout.

We are very grateful for the support of the local community and hope this advance notice helps with planning around the road closures. CLOSURE AND REOPENING OF ROADS

- Road closures start at 05:00 on Whitehall, Parliament Street, Piccadilly, St James Street and Pall Mall, with the majority of other roads closing at 07:00.
- We will be operating a dynamic reopening schedule to ensure that roads are reopened as soon as possible and when it is safe and feasible to do so. All roads will fully reopen by 14:00, unless stated above. Please note roads neighbouring the route may also be affected.
- Advanced warning signs will be installed two weeks prior to the event to provide closure information.
- Please do allow extra time for your journey, and where possible, avoid driving in the area during the closures. If you do need your vehicle during Sunday 12 July please consider parking on alternative roads outside of the road closures.
- Emergency service and pedestrian access will be facilitated throughout.

PARKING SUSPENSIONS

- To facilitate the route and event infrastructure, parking suspensions will be in place on the roads marked with  from midnight on Sunday 12 July, with suspensions on Carlton House Terrace & Waterloo Place from midnight on Saturday 11 July.
- Advanced notices of the parking restrictions will be installed in the days prior to the event, indicating where these parking suspensions will be in place.
- **Please note any vehicles parked in contravention of any parking restriction will be removed by tow-truck.**
- If you require the use of your vehicle during the road closure times, we recommend you park outside of the road closure area.

ACCESS POINTS

- A** St James's area/Piccadilly
 Access between 05:00 - 08:30 and from 11:00: Old Bond Street/Piccadilly/Duke Street St James's St to Arlington St/Over St James's St to Arlington St for drop off.
 Egress: 05:00 - 09:10 and from 11:00: Arlington Street over Piccadilly onto Dover Street
- B** Leicester Square
 Before 08:30
 Access: Cranbourne St to Leicester Sq.
 Egress: Irving Street/Orange Street/Charing Cross Road/Great Newport Street.
- C** High Timber/Upper Thames Street
 Access throughout closures:
 Access 1, Queen Victoria Street/Puddle Dock/Upper Thames Street (eastbound only), and 2, from end of Southwark Bridge/Upper Thames Street. Egress: westwards up Puddle Dock/Queen Victoria Street (no access to Blackfriars Underpass) or eastbound along Upper Thames Street.
